Conditions of Entry: Entry is conditional upon acceptance of these conditions.

1. Entry fee is \$3 per event or \$35 per combination for 'wristband' entry into eligible events throughout the day.
2. Allen Fountain Memorial Trophy (Judged on Workout, Presentation & Pony Club General Knowledge) Entry fee \$5 (see details relating to conditions of this event on pg 3).
3. Games Ring entry fee \$3 per event or 'wristband' entry. Spurs & whips not permitted.
4. Before riding:
 - a. All open competitors must sign a day attendance form; and if a current pony club card cannot be presented, pay an additional \$10.00
 - b. PCAV club member cards must be presented at the secretary's office.
5. No entry fee will be refunded.
6. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
7. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel, divide or merge any class or competition; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
8. Gear check: Pony club sections require gear check before riding. (Open show rings excluded)
 - a. Medical Armbands are required to be worn by all competitors (including non-pony club).
9. All riders must wear complying helmets. Spot checks to ensure compliance may occur.
10. Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCAV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
11. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
12. No stallions, colts or rigs.
13. Rings will not be held up for any reasons.
14. One horse /one rider rule in novelty and pony club events. Individuals may choose to ride more than one mount in Open events, however they may only ride one mount per event.
15. No double bridles. Plaiting and jackets optional. Dress may be pony club uniform or open riders neat and tidy attire.
16. A novice is a rider or horse that has never won a first place in an applicable event.
17. PCAV Alcohol Policy applies.
18. PCAV Lungeing Policy applies.
19. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.

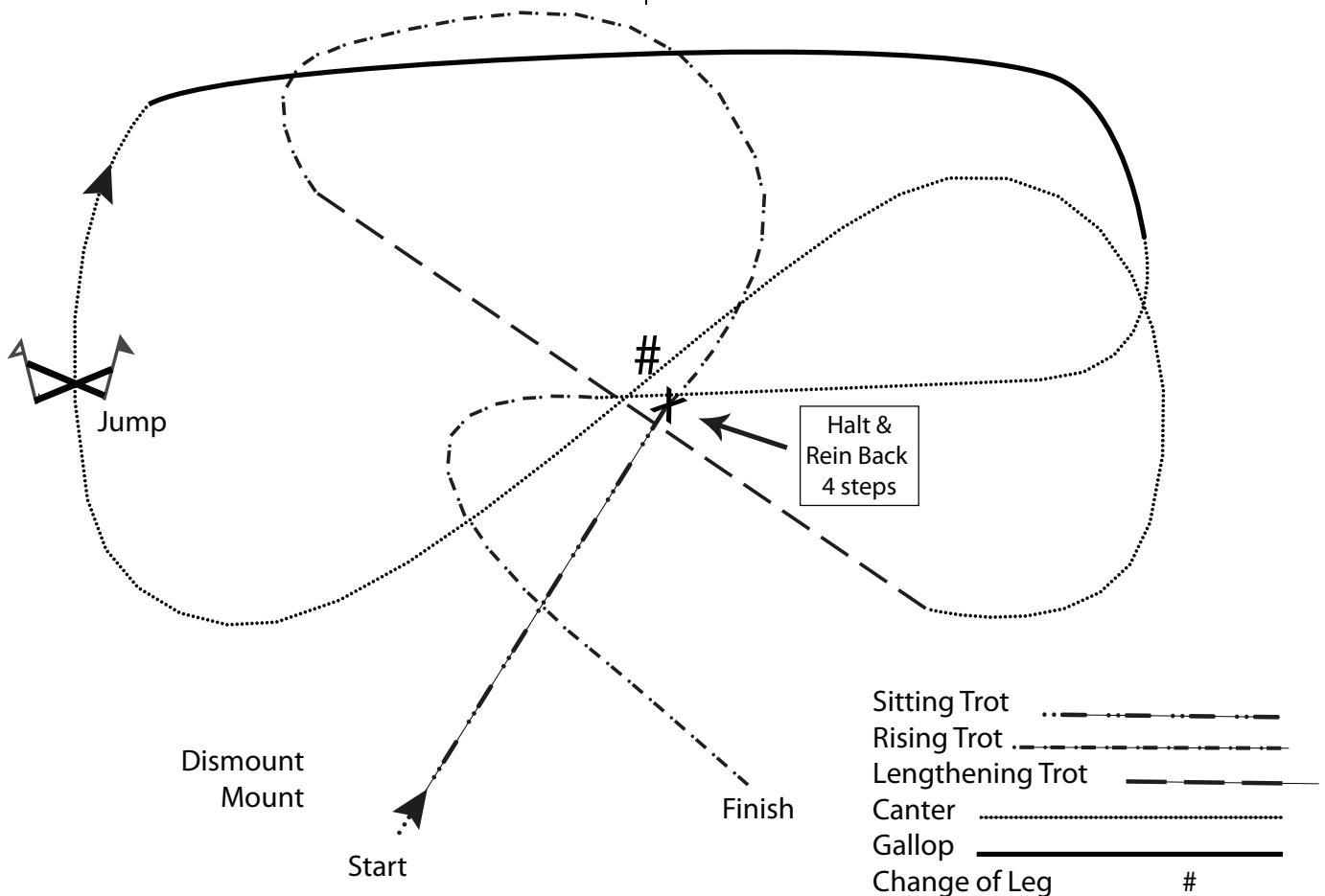
The Allen Fountain Memorial Trophy is an event open to all PCAV pony club members under 26 years of age. Combination must be eligible under PCAV Rules.

In a case where it is deemed by the Official Veterinary Officer that on humanitarian grounds the above named horse should be destroyed because of illness, injury or accident, I hereby give the Official Veterinary Officer and the President of Swan Hill Pony Club, or the appointed deputy, permission to act in accordance with the recommendation of the Official Veterinary Officer in this matter. Before taking this action the President of the Swan Hill Pony Club, or the appointed deputy, must be satisfied that every possible practical effort has been made to contact the accompanying parent/guardian/responsible adult named above. I list below any special conditions or instructions as to the disposal of the horse after such action by the Official Veterinary Officer.

Horse Event Declaration Waiver
